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## **Technical Note on Monetary and Financial Statistics**

## Technical Note on Monetary and Financial Statistics

### Monetary Survey (Depository Corporations Survey)

Monetary Survey shows the condition of money and credit of a country. It covers assets and liabilities including money and credit data of the whole banking system affected on the economic condition of a country.

### Monetary Base (M0)

Monetary Base or Reserve Money or Base Money or high-powered money comprises central bank's liabilities that support the expansion of broad money and credit.

$$\text{Monetary Base (M0)} = \text{Currency in Circulation (CIC)} + \text{Transferable deposits of banks and other financial institutions (for required reserves and clearing balances)}$$

### Currency Outside Depository Corporations

Currency in Circulation (CIC) is the main part of money supply and consists of notes and coins held by the general public. However, the notes and coins held (vault cash) of the Central Bank are excluded. So, Currency in Circulation is defined as the central bank's total currency issuance less its currency holdings. Currency outside depository corporations is the currency liabilities of the depository corporations including central bank and is defined as the currency in circulation (CIC) less the other depository corporations' holdings of national currency.

$$\text{Currency in Circulation (CIC)} = \text{Currency issued by Central Bank} - \text{Notes and coins held as vault cash in the Central Bank}$$

$$\text{Currency Outside Depository Corporations} = \text{Currency in Circulation (CIC)} - \text{Currency holdings of other depository corporations (or banks)}$$

### Money Supply

Money supply is the aggregates money within an economic system in a given period. The various types of money in the money supply are generally classified as M1, M2 and M3, according to the type and size of the account in which the instrument is kept. **Money supply (M1)** or narrow money consists of currency in circulation (CIC) and transferable (demand) deposits. **Money supply (M2)** or broad money covers M1 and other deposits which include savings certificates, savings deposits, time deposits and other deposits.

$$M1 = \text{Currency outside depository corporations} + \text{Transferable (Demand) Deposits}$$

$$M2 = M1 + \text{Saving Deposits} + \text{Time Deposits} + \text{Saving Certificates} + \text{Other deposits}$$

## Demand Deposit (Transferable Deposit)

Transferable deposit comprises all deposits that are exchangeable on demand at par, without penalty or restriction, and that are otherwise commonly used to directly make payment.

$$\text{Transferable deposits} = \text{Current Accounts} + \text{ATM Accounts} + \text{Demand Deposits}$$

## Quasi-Money

Quasi-Money comprises all claims, other than transferable deposits, that are represented by evidence of deposits. It includes Saving Deposits, Time Deposits, Saving Certificates, and Other deposits.

$$\text{Quasi-Money} = \text{Saving Deposits} + \text{Time Deposits} + \text{Saving Certificates} + \text{Other deposits}$$

## Loans

Loans are financial assets that include all loans and advances extended to various sectors by financial corporations, government, public nonfinancial corporations and private nonfinancial corporations and households.

$$\text{Loans} = \text{Short-term and long-term loans} + \text{Borrowing from Central Bank} + \text{Borrowing from Banks and financial Institutions}$$

## Securities Other Than Shares

Securities other than shares are negotiable instruments serving as evidence that units have obligations to settle by means of providing cash, a financial instrument, or some other item of economic value. Some common types of securities are government treasury bills, government bonds, corporate bonds and debentures, commercial paper and certificates of deposits issued by depository corporations.

$$\text{Securities Other Than Shares} = \text{Government Treasury Bonds} + \text{Government Treasury Bills}$$

## Net Foreign Assets (NFA)

Net foreign assets (NFA) are the net amount between the foreign assets (claims on nonresidents) and foreign liabilities (liabilities to nonresidents) of depository corporations which covers central bank and banks. The foreign assets comprise monetary gold, SDR holding, foreign currency, transferable deposit and other deposits, sundry deposits and securities included in official reserve assets, securities of nonresidents, other account receivables on nonresidents. The foreign liabilities cover transferable deposits of nonresidents, other foreign liabilities, and other account payable to nonresidents (Asia clearing union account).

$$\text{Net Foreign Assets (NFA)} = \text{Claims on Nonresidents} - \text{Liabilities to Nonresidents}$$

## Net Claims on Central Government

Net claims on Central Government shows the net basis for the Claims on Central Government less liabilities to Central Government. The presentation on a net basis facilitates the analysis of depository corporations' financing of central government operations. Claims on Central Government comprise the Government Treasury Bonds and Government Treasury Bills, Overdraft from Government Deposits, Overdraft from the Ministries and Department' deposits and settlement account. Liabilities to Central Government cover transferable deposits of Central Government by national currency and foreign currency, loans from Central Government (payable for foreign loans), and settlement account.

$$\text{Net Claims on Central Government} = \text{Claims on Central Government} - \text{Liabilities to Central Government}$$

## Claims on Other Sectors

Claims on Other Sectors are disaggregated into the claims on (1) state and local government, (2) public nonfinancial corporations, (3) other financial corporations and (4) private sector or resident sector comprising nonfinancial corporations and households. It covers the securities other than shares, loans, shares and other equity and settlement accounts by respective sectors.

$$\text{Claims on Other Sectors} = \text{Claims on State and Local Government} + \text{Claims on Public Nonfinancial Corporations} + \text{Claims on Other Financial Corporations} + \text{Claims on Private Sector}$$

## Domestic Credit (DC)

Domestic Credit comprises net claims on central government and claims on other sectors.

$$\text{Domestic Credit (DC)} = \text{Net Claims on Central Government} + \text{Claims on Other Sectors}$$

## Other Items Net (OIN)

Other Items Net (OIN) refers a residual category for other liabilities less other assets, when other liabilities include all liabilities not included in broad money. Other assets include CBM claims on other depository corporations (transferable deposits and loans), Required Reserves and Clearing Balance of ODC, Transferable Deposits and Other Deposits at CBM and Other Claims on CBM (Financial Adjustment or Settlement Account). Other liabilities cover liabilities to other depository corporations (transferable deposits and other deposits), and Loans from CBM.

$$\text{Other Items Net} = \text{Other Liabilities} - \text{Other Assets}$$

$$\text{Broad Money Liabilities (BML)} = \text{NFA} + \text{DC} - \text{OIN}$$

$$\Delta \text{BML} = \Delta \text{NFA} + \Delta \text{DC} - \Delta \text{OIN}$$

**Consumer Price Index (CPI):** The country's Consumer Price Index (CPI) are released by the Central Statistical Organization (CSO). (80) Townships in the state and region to price collection have been previously collected from the Planning Department Now, the Central Statistical Organization's regional offices are collected and sent to Naypyitaw headquarters by e-mail or fax.

**Concept and definition:** Consumer Price Index measures the average change in the retail prices of goods and services purchased and consumed by the households. The weights are based on 2006 Household Income and Expenditure Survey (HIES) conducted by the Central Statistical Organization (CSO).The main purpose is to measure for the rate of inflation and to use regulate bonuses for Public salary.

**Weight:** In December 2006, CSO Conducted Household Income and Expenditure Survey (HIES) in (80) Township for (32000) households. Consumer Expenditure Weighting, Based on national Household Income and Expenditure Survey 2006.

**Coverage:** CPI was covered only urban area based on the HIES 2006. The Central Statistical Organization collects retail prices of selected commodities for computation of Monthly Price Index at Union, States and Regions, Capital cities.

**Classification:** Weights and composition are grouped into eight major categories of goods and services in 2006 base. CPI groups are selected on the basis of their importance and representativeness. The computation of CPI is based on 158 commodities for 2006 base which are commonly used by most of the households.

**Calculation Method:** The CPI is compiled using the standard Laspeyres formula.

Where  $P_1$  = Current price,  $P_0$  = Base year price,  $Q_0$  = Base year quantity and  $P_0 Q_0$ =weight
