

Foreigners, holding an International Driving Licence, are permitted to drive with prior permission and the fee is USD 20 for one year. *Clothing*

Light wears throughout most of the year with rainwear for Rainy Season. Warmer clothing may be required for coolest period and some evenings.

Passports

Required by all.

Visas

- Required by all.
- Children over seven years of age require a separate visa even if travelling on their parents' passports.
- Tourists visas are obtainable from Myanmar Mission abroad and are valid for 28 days (for 2 weeks visa extension USD 36 and for one month USD 72). Tourists may only stay in hotels and guest houses.

Customs

Foreign currencies (above USD 2000), jewelleries and electrical goods must be declared to the customs at the Airport.

For customs clearance, a Green Channel for visitors with nothing to declare and Red Channel for visitors with dutiable items. Exports of antiques and archaeologically valuable items are prohibited.

Foreign Exchange

Foreign Independent Travellers holding tourist visas must exchange on arrival a minimum of USD 200 or equivalent into foreign exchange certificates. Any unused foreign exchange certificates out of this amount will not be reconverted.







TOURIST ARRIVALS BY GENDER GROUP








TOURIST ARRIVALS BY AGE GROUP


