Regulation
Issued under Section 9 of the Emergency Decree
on Public Administration in Emergency Situations B.E. 2548 (2005)
(No. 4)

Pursuant to the Declaration of an Emergency Situation in all areas of the Kingdom of Thailand as from 26 March B.E. 2563 (2020) and the Notification on the Extension of Duration of the Declaration of an Emergency Situation in all areas of the Kingdom of Thailand (1st Extension) issued on 28 April B.E. 2563 (2020), which shall take effect from 1 May B.E. 2563 (2020) to 31 May B.E. 2563 (2020);

Whereas the Government has been constantly and consecutively monitoring and following the situation of the outbreak of the communicable disease COVID-19, both in Thailand and other countries, and has assigned those responsible for public health, economy, public administration and security to jointly assess the situation in order to consider relaxing or intensifying the enforcement of certain measures with the aim of being able to quickly end the control and remedy for the emergency situation in a permanent manner, allowing people to carry on their normal lives peacefully while complying with disease prevention measures and recommendations of the government, the Government shall consider relaxing measures in a systematic manner according to criteria determined by the World Health Organization and take into account, as a priority, types of businesses or activities with low risk, places where supervising and monitoring systems can be set up, and persons concerned who can implement disease prevention measures, with the initial period being used, for the time being, for preparations in support of the setting up of systems in accordance with the measures and recommendations of the government;

By virtue of Section 9 of the Emergency Decree on Public Administration in Emergency Situations B.E. 2548 (2005) and Section 11 of the State Administration Act B.E. 2534 (1991), the Prime Minister hereby issues regulations and guidelines for government agencies as follows:

All Notifications or Orders of the Governor of Bangkok, Provincial Governors and communicable disease control officers issued under the laws on communicable diseases and of persons having powers under the laws on air navigation and the laws on immigration, issued or ordered prior to the coming into effect of this Regulation, be they prohibitions, permissions or relaxations, which are deemed as a Notification or Order under the Regulations issued under

Section 9 of the Emergency Decree on Public Administration in Emergency Situations B.E. 2548 (2005), shall remain in force until a Regulation, Notification or Order is issued otherwise.

This Regulation shall come into effect on 1 May B.E. 2563 (2020).
