Peace Process highlights and International Aids

- Ongoing armed conflict in Kachin and Shan State and fresh armed violence in Rakhine State.
- 2. The 4th peace talk led by the State Counsellor was held in Wundwin, Mandalay Region
- 3. SSPP/SSA has resigned from the UNFC and joined FPNCC. KNPP, NMSP, LDU and ANC remains active member of UNFC.
- 4. The 6th official meeting between the Peace Commission and UNFC was held in Yangon. Signing NCA and agreement on UNFC 9 points proposal still remains unsettled.
- 5. A statement from the FPNCC meeting in Pangkham said that they will participate in the 3rd session of the 21st Century Panlong if invited and proposed more active cooperation of China on the peace process.
- 6. Tatmadaw pressured the NMSP not to hold military parades on the 70th Mon Revolution Day.
- 7. NSCN-K claimed that without reaching an agreement that covers the ethnic Naga people in both Myanmar and India, they will not sign the nationwide ceasefire agreement (NCA)
- 8. Scheduled meeting between Peace Commission and FPNCC has been cancelled due to the government policy to meet them separately.
- The Thai government did not allow ENAC to hold its workshop with ethnic political parties and other alliances in Chiangmai, claiming that hey did not receive permission from NRPC
- 10.Tatmadaw blocked Kachin NGO Myu Sha Zinblum humanitarian convoys to provide aid to IDPs in Namti Town, Kachin State. The 88 Generation Peace and Open Society also said it has been prevented from delivering food supply to Lisu IDPs in Sadone Township, Kachin State.
- 11. Curfew in Maungdaw Township, Rakhine, was extended to 2 more months on 9 August, after starting following 2012 communal violence.
- 12.Myanmar Government Anti-Terrorism Central Committee declared ARSA a terrorist group who claimed responsibilities for deadly multi-attacks on Myanmar police posts in Yathedaung and Buthidaung Township, Rakhine State on 25th of August. UN Security Council met, and China was resisting stronger involvement by the UN council in addressing the crisis.
- 13.Mr Kofi Annan led the Rakhine Investigation Commission launched their fact finding report on Rakhine incidents.
