



Sihanoukville-HK Cable

Intra-Asia

The Sihanoukville-Hong Kong Submarine Cable connects Sihanoukville, Cambodia and Hong Kong, spanning approximately 3000km across the South China Sea.

The project will be invested by the Cambodian Ministry of Posts and Telecommunications (MPT) and China Unicom Global. The two parties signed agreement in Beijing on October 17, 2023, during the Third Belt and Road Forum for International Cooperation.

The Sihanoukville-Hong Kong Submarine Cable System will be first state-owned submarine optical fiber cable for Cambodia.

The Sihanoukville-Hong Kong Submarine Cable System is expected to cost over US\$165million, with majority of the investment by the Cambodian MPT. Cambodia has secured fund for the project and obtained loans from the Chinese government. Cambodia will use the profits from the sale of the Internet service to repay the loans.

The Sihanoukville-Hong Kong Submarine Cable System will be supplied by HMN Tech, to be completed in July 2025.
