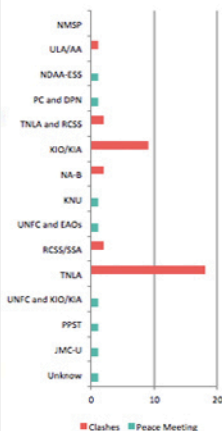
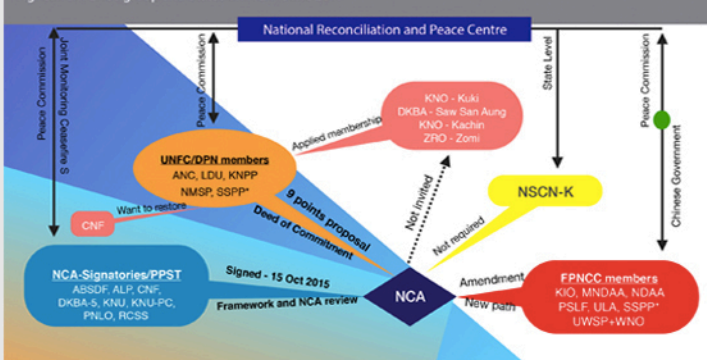
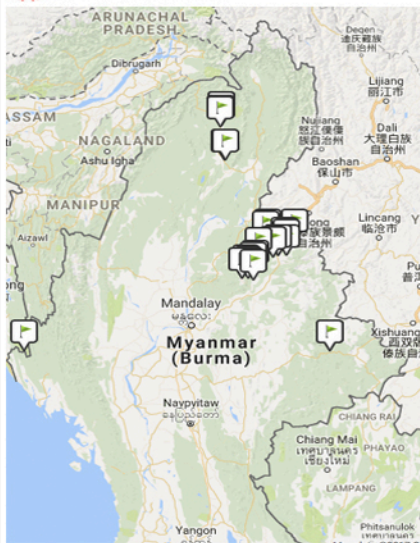


Fig: Current EAOs group and Status on NCA - June 2017

Peace Process highlights

1. Tatmadaw ordered residents and workers to leave from gold and amber mines in Danai Township. Also another ordered to villagers to avoid any activities 5000m away from Ledo road between Danai and Kamaing town claiming that Tatmadaw will exercise military operation.
2. IDPs from Danai township facing relocation and 28 groups of Kachin CSOs condemn the blockage of humanitarian access for local and international aid groups to IDPs by authorities.
3. Clashes in Tanai Township - Kachin and Northern Shan State escalated between Tatmadaw and EAOs.
4. During the 2nd Congress of UNFC accepted the resignation of the KIO, PSFL, MNDAA and WNO. UNFC leaders reshuffle and Delegation of Political Negotiation members re-elected. UNFC 9 points proposal still remains unsettled.
5. UNFC members and 103 delegates from other political alliances released a statement on the situation and outcomes of the 2nd Session of UPC – 21st Century Panglong stating it has weaknesses and failure to abide by positions and guarantees contained in the Framework for Political Dialogue and NCA principles. Also KNU and RCSS released a statement with similar findings earlier.
6. Peace Process Steering Team (PPST) statement stated that there are different understanding and defining of NCA on the implementation process between Government, Tatmadaw and EAO-S. As a result, there are weakness in NCA implementation.
7. There are 38 civilians killed and 22 missing between October 2016 to June 2017 according to National Security Advisors report.
8. The Canadian Government will contribute \$8.8 million in support for humanitarian assistance and the advancement of peace and stability in Myanmar.
9. Three journalists from DVB and The Irawaddy arrested in Northern Shan State returning from to covered the story of drug-burning event on the International Day Against Drug Abuse and Illicit Trafficking organized by the TNLA
