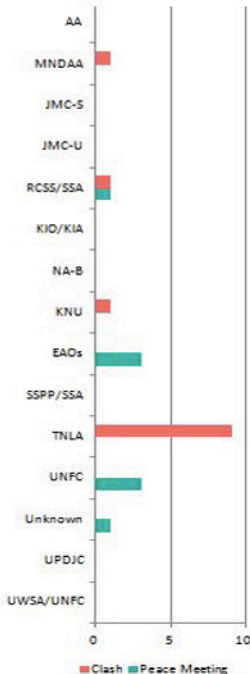

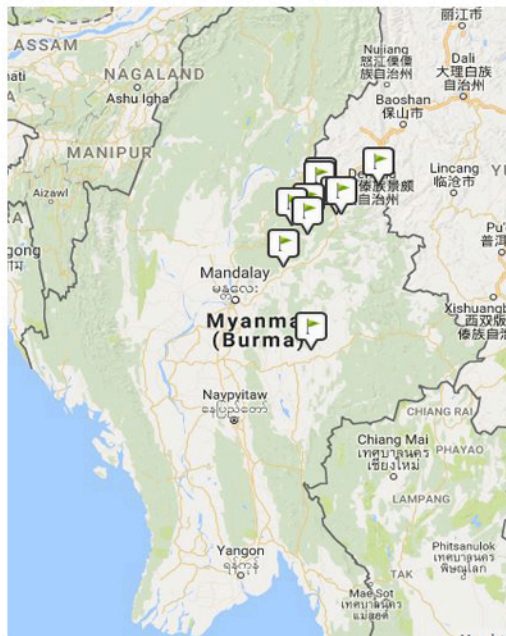

Peace Process highlights

- Ongoing armed clashes: TMD and RCSS, TMD and KNU, TMD and TNLA, TMD and MNDAA
- Meeting: JICM, UPDJC, JMC-S, CT and DPN, PC and DPN, 14 EAOs (62 representatives)
- State Counselor rejected to hold an ethnic-based national-level political dialogue in Arakan State, saying it is a sensitive region.
- UNFC pledged to follow political dialogue according to NCA but ULA/AA, MNDAA and PSLF/TNLA decided not to follow NCA path
- Tatmadaw and Local police searched United Wa State Army (UWSA) liaison office in Lashio. The UWSA claimed the search was unlawful.
- The 4th Ethnic summit was held in Pangkham UWSA HQ. 27 reps from UWSA, AA, KIA, MNDAA, TNLA attended the summit and formed political negotiation committee
- Shan State government and eligible groups held regional National-level political dialogue in Taunggyi, Shan State
- Tatmadaw will not accept any revisions or amendments to a nationwide cease-fire agreement it signed in October 2015
- May 24 set as the date for the second session of the UPC - 21st Century Panglong
- 10.23 human rights groups called on international pressure to allow UN fact-finding mission to investigate the abuses in Rakhine, Kachin and Shan State, as recently mandated by the UNSC
- Myanmar government received Peace Process funds worth US\$1m out of \$3m from China government
- United Nations donated US\$6.5m to JMC-U according to JCB permission.
