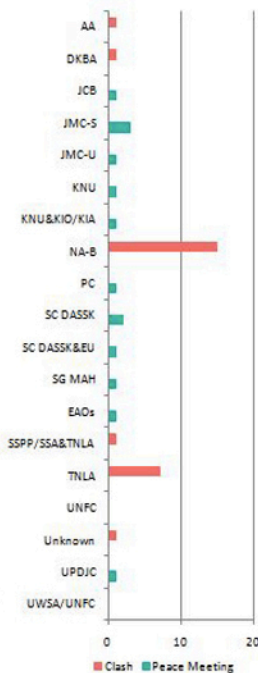

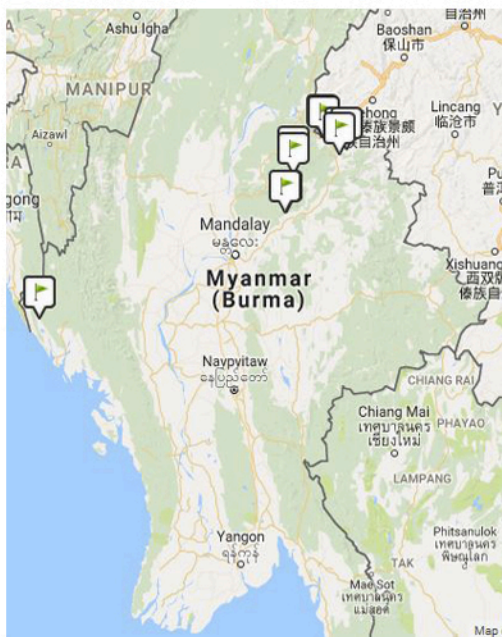

**Peace Process highlights**

1. National Level Political Dialogue held in Thantlang, Chin State and Hopong, Shan State
2. UPC-21st Panglong Conference postponed - it was originally planned for the 28th February 2017
3. The 70th anniversary of Union Day was held in Panglong, Shan State
4. The 3rd EAOs summit organized by UWSA was held in Panghsang and released a statement stating that the current NCA should be abandoned. UWSA leader urge to seek new path to peace.
5. UPDJC assigned Working Committees and formed supervision committees for Political Dialogues at the National-Level formed for Chin State, Shan State and Bago Region
6. The 9th meeting of UPDJC took place in NayPataw and JMC in Yangon.
7. Joint Coordinating Body – JCB (20 members led by State Counsellor) meeting approved to seek and receive US\$13.7m for the peace process implementation.
8. KNU met KIO/KIA in Laiza and Chinese Authorities in Kuming, China
9. TNLA, AA and MNDAA are not recognized as political armed group, it was claimed by General Mya Tun Oo
10. 1st National level CSO forum held in NayPayTaw and preliminary forum in Taungyi
11. Kachin National Conference was on-hold but permitted later under the name of "Meeting" instead "Conference"
12. "Wheel Chair" peace movement journey started from Myitkyina on the 15th Feb arrived NayPayTaw on the 28th of Feb and met State Counsellor.
13. Curfew in Maungdaw, Rakhine State has been withdrawn and the border gate 1 was re-opened
14. Investigation Commission team led by VP U Myint Swe visited Maungdaw as the 4th mission.
15. UK and US ambassadors visited Kachin state and confirmed they will continue to provide aid to IDPs and assisting the peace process
